<u>Accommodation</u>: Were in 4 hotels: three for the delegations:

AL-Fanar 5* and Region 5*, very good hotels with all facilities for the

wheelchair players

Palmyra 3* in this hotel were a lot of different problems (warm water,

heating, sometimes meal too, some bad rooms)

Grand Palace 4* there were only 5 officials – very good hotel

Meals:

Breakfasts and dinners were served in the hotels.

Lunches were served directly in Venue.

Farewell dinner:

Organized in the hotel Al-Fanar - special dinner and very nice music group.

Participants: 22 nations were present 209 players

40 escorts **249 participants in total!**

<u>Transport</u>: Transport from Airport to hotels was with some small problems only (very

big number of the participants). Much more problems were after the

tournament, during the departure of the delegations.

The local transport among the hotels Al-Fanar, Region, Grand Palace and

Venue was O.K.

The delegation which stay in hotel Palmyra had sometimes problems, mainly

in two first days.

<u>Venue</u>: **Prince Raad bin Zeid Complex** (two playing halls)

Floor: special lino in the both of them

Lighting: very good in the bigger one and not too good

in the smaller one (for wheelchairs)

Spectator seats: approximately 250 seats on the tribunes in the big hall

only place for wheelchairs spectators in small hall

Referee's table: on special stand in the middle of the longer side in big

hall and the same in the small hall

Gluing room: in the extra part of the Venue, very near to both of

halls

Evaluation: Accommodations: very good in the hotels Al Fanar, Region and Grand

Palace, but in hotel Palmyra were a lot of problems. OC tried to solve them, but some of them were not possible to solve. OC promised wont use this hotel for the accommodation of the next tournaments.

<u>Meals:</u> very good in three hotels and only not bad in hotel Palmyra. In hotels were served breakfasts and dinners.

Good lunches were served in the special place in

Venue.

Transport: The transport from Airport to hotels was without some

bigger problems, although the number of participants was very big, but the Delegations arrived during two

days.

The local transport between hotels Al Fanar, Region, Grand Palace and Venue was without problems. Worse it was between hotel Palmyra and Venue. The first two days were no some correct timeschedule of shuttle there and players had to use sometimes a cab, when they need to go to Venue. Next days it was already

better.

The transport from hotels to Airport, during the departure of delegations had some big problems. Buses were coming sometimes too late to hotels and some participants had the problems to catch their flights. Two French players had to use even next flight connection. Therefore they had to buy new tickets, they asked now OC to pay out them the airtickets.

Venue: Was too small for 22 tables and we had to use the size

of the field for the standing only 10 x 5m and for the wheelchairs only 6 x 5m. We spoke about this problem with the managers during the Technical meeting and they promised wont protest against the size of field during the tournament. Nevertheless we had the problem with the too small hall for three days tournaments only, but OC in cooperation with the Officials and all of the participants managed the whole programme of the tournament and finished it in the

normal time.

<u>Tables</u>: We used 20 - 22 tables. It was a pity we had to use

two different mark of tables – Stiga and Stag. Once again, we warn of the problem during the Technical meeting too. We had the right number of accessible

tables for wheelchair players.

<u>Referee:</u> Patrick Ringel was excellent referee for the job there.

He worked daily maybe 16-18 hours, to prepare all

perfectly.

From him it was the best possible professional work!! Without the referee of his quality, we never were able to finish well and in time so big tournament there.

<u>Deputy Referees</u>: Both of deputies cooperate perfectly with referee and

they made there professional work too.

<u>Umpires</u>: nevertheless we had there only 31 umpires for 20 - 22

tables, they worked very hard and well, no some

official protest during the tournament.

Computermen: both of them, very good cooperation with referee –

perfect work.

In conclusion :

Before I started to write this part of my Report I read or heard a lot of comments about the OC of Jordan Open 2007. Yes, Organizers made some mistakes and some of them really bad for some of the participants. It is true, but I cannot agree, they were as bad as some people tried to speak about them.

Why?

- 1. OC organized before this tournament already four next tournaments, but no one of them had more than 80 players this year were there 209 players
- 2. In OC are very hardworking people, which the whole time try to learn from officials how to organize better their tournaments. The size of this tournament took them by surprise and therefore probably they made most of the mistakes
- 3. They were unlucky with the very cold weather and snow-fall too which handicapped their transport and made problems with the heating in the Venue and hotel Palmyra
- 4. Jordanian PC is only one in the Middle East, who is able to organize our

- tournaments and we really need somebody in this part of Asia & Oceania Region. Silas Chiang, which came there for short visite during the Jordanian Open 2007, had very similar opinion about the Organizers.
- 5. I agree, OC of Jordanian Open 2007 didnt manage the tournament well, but I am sure, if we give them the opportunity to organize some next tournaments, they will organize them already in much better level, like this year
- 6. I think, the too negative appreciation of the work of OC wont help us, only we could lose good OC, which only didnt know to manage very big tournament. Most of the organizers are enthusiasts, which like the work for our tournaments, we need to teach them only, to be able to organize the big our tournaments too. Here could help us some good education of the Organizers of the tournaments
