Accommodation: Organizing committee used two hotels for players and staff in single or double bedrooms. Information about wheelchair accessibility was given by the general information sheet from the organizer. Only in Máj Hotel were a limited number of rooms available for wheelchairs (class 1 and 2) available.

Meals: All meals were served in the hotels. Quality of food was good. Well organized.

Water: Water for participants was available in the venue.

Transport: Distance Hotels <> venue: +/- 400 meter. Only from the Maj hotel (especially for class 1 and 2) were two shuttles available. Other daily transport was not necessary.

Venue: Organizer used the Ice rink.

Number of tables: 25 (15 wheelchair and 10 standing).
Floors: blue plastic.

Referee table: There was space in the Ice hall for referee and umpires.

Notes:

- * By special permission from ITTF/PTTD, “only for this tournament”, team matches in Robin Round (groups 4 and 5 players) would be played in best of 5 games instead of 3 games.
- *Not all players could take part in this tournament because of the volcano of Iceland. Some teams travelled more than 30 hours by car/bus. This is also a good sign for a well organized tournament.
- *Temperature Ice hall: Conform the contract between ITTF <> organizer, point 6.7.5 the temperature must not less than 16° C. Control during the tournament gave as result: morning 14° C and afternoon 17° C. The opinion of most of the players +/- 20° C may be better.
