Most of Hotels were full accessible for players but number of players with severe disability had some problems in their hotel,all arranged in single and double bed room.

The accommodation not close to venue and transport was not organize well to move participants to Venue and back.



Accreditation:

The persons who works in Accreditation had good experiences and worked well They gave a baggage to delegations includes:

T-shirt for tournament, back number of players, gourd bottle, some souvenirs, Bulletin and brushers.



Meals:

Breakfast served in the hotels where the delegations slept there. Lunch and dinner served in venue (Ahoy). Foods served self service with multiple choice and kinds of foods with very good quality.



Transport from / to airport / Hotel /Venue:

Transport from airport to Hotel and back arranged wellbut with sometimes in case of delay .

They arranged some of them were accessible for wheelchair.

Transport from Hotel to Venue and back had some problems on time and the delegations were not pleased with transport.



Venue:

Venue Ahoy was a little far from the Hotels, the sport hall was full accessible with 36 tables for matches, there were enough water for participants (gallons & bottles). It was nearby the WTTTC sport hall and good opportunity for our players to see world championship competition for able body players.





Training Hall

There were two training halls with a lot of tables that available during the days.



- Playing hall:** With 36 tables – DHS blue ITTF approved
- Floor:** sport flooring
- Lighting:** enough
- Referee's table:** special room, Deputy Referee, computer staff in playing hall
- Medical service:** First aid presented in the sport hall without any sign or guidance panel
- Officials' room:** special room
- Spectator seats:** Approximately 2000 or more seats
- Ball selection area:** There was wide area for players to select the ball for match




Classification:
