**Accommodation:** OC used the hotel Van der Valk Airport hotel Duesseldorf ( 4 \* ), fully accessible for the wheelchairs – big rooms (38 square metres ), the doors to big bathrooms were 75 cm and in the bathroom were the bath and the shower too.

**Meals:** Breakfast and dinner were served in the hotel and in the excellent quality. Lunches were served in the special dining room of the Venue. The quality of the meals there, were good and the meals were well served too.

**Drinking programme:** In the all of three playing halls was O.K.too. The Organizers gave to every participant the special plastic bottles and everybody could take the water to these bottles from the automatic glass barrels which were there.

**Transport:** The transport between the Airport Duesseldorf and hotel was organized by the buses and vans very well. The local transport between the hotel and Venue was organized well too. OC prepared the good time schedule of the shuttle for the playing days.

**Venue :** **Deutsches Tischtennis Zentrum, Ernst-Poensgen-Allee 58, Duesseldorf**

**We used three halls in one big building.**

**Hall 1- for the players classes 1 - 5 :**

**Number of tables:** 8 tables Butterfly, accessible for wheelchairs, blue  
**Flooring:** taraflex, red  
**Light :** between 700 - 750 Lux, no daily light

**Hall 2 – for the players class 6 – 10 :**

**Number of the tables :** 9 tables Andro-Magnus, blue  
**Flooring :** special lino, red  
**Light :** between 1200 – 1300 Lux, no daily light

**Computerman's table :** the same place

**Light :** between 700 – 750 Lux

**Accessible toilets :** in the Venue were 3 special big toilets fully accessible for the wheelchairs +3 next bigger toilets for classes 4 + 5

February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2012 normal arrival day, classification, practice, draw of  
Singles, the manager's meeting  
February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012 Single in classes  
February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Teams events  
February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Teams events + medals ceremony  
February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012 after the breakfast the departure of the delegations

**Ball boys/girls:** On Friday 40 students from the secondary school, on Saturday and on Sunday 25 pupils from the primary school. All of them helped the players very well.

**Meetings :** The technical meeting was hold on February 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 9 pm in the meeting room of the hotel. The managers of the delegations got there all of needed general information, and draw of the Singles + time schedule for the first day too.

**Classification:** The classification was conducted on February 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, in the Fit centre of the hotel. In the room for the classification were all of needed equipments and players were coming there exactly following the time schedule. OC prepared it very well. There were prepared some drinks and snakes for the classifiers too. Aart Kruimer and Emre Baskan made the classification of 18 players from the 4 countries. During the tournament they still observed seven players. Classification was made without some problems, the classifiers team was really excellent.

**Results :** Already when some part of the event was finished, the Organizers gave the results on the inform desk and after the tournament every delegation and officials got the\_CD ROM with the full results and with the data\_common too. Therefore we had the playing days from Friday to Sunday ,the deputy referee sent the results of Single in Classes to Gael Marziou for PTT web on Friday evening. On Sunday afternoon, when we finished the Team's Event, Bernhard Karau sent the rest of the results on PTT web too.



**The players followed the results on the inform desk.**

**Medical service :** During the whole tournament was before the playing hall prepared the ambulance car with the crew. The crew was prepared to give the first aid and if necessary to call for the doctor.

On the start of team event one of the players ( young girl ) of Chinese Taipei team had fallen into black out and in the some minutes helped her not only the crew of the ambulance car, but the doctor from near hospital too. They gave her directly in the hall the effective first aid and after it they took her in hospital for some next tests too. In one hour she was back in the hall and already without some health problems.

**Ceremonies:** No Opening and Closing Ceremonies were there. The all of medals Ceremonies were Organized after the end of the both of events.

**Evaluation:** **Accommodations** – Van der Valk Airport hotel Duesseldorf was really very good. Oivind Eriksen wrote about it in Side Inspection Report in detail and appended there a lot of the documentary photos, therefore I can only repeat his words – it was excellent hotel for all of classes of players. The very big rooms and comfortable bathrooms were fully accessible for them. The breakfast and dinner in its dinning room were every day above the standard. The participants could use on the rooms free internet and to go to swimming pool, to sauna or to Fit center too. The buses needed only 15–20 minuts for the transport from the hotel to the Venue.

**Transport -** The both of transports ( Airport – hotel and local, hotel – Venue ) were organized very well, with the corresponding number of needed buses and minibuses.

**Sport equipment -** Very good, ITTF and ITTF PTTD approved.

**Information:** The time schedule and draw were on the information board , and all of next information were in the pigeonholes. The information for the participants were good there, during the whole tournament.

**Referee + deputy :** Very good and professional work, but nevertheless, for the next tournament I offered to OC to have still next one deputy referee, therefore this year deputy referee had to much different works without the possibility for some break during the whole tournament.

**Umpires:** OC had for the tournament together 26 umpires. From the number only one was from abroad, but during the whole tournament, we hadn't some problems with their job. Some of them were ITTF umpires, some of them national umpires only, but all of them made perfect job. OC will have to try to invite more umpires from abroad for the next tournament.

**Computer servis:** The computerman Stephan Loedige and deputy referee Bernhard Karau knew very well Dr.Wu system and therefore the computer servis was very good and always organized in time. After the end of the tournament, they prepared CD ROMs for the each of the delegation and for each of the officials.

**Ball boys/girls :** Susanne Epstein was the coordinator of the ballchildren, during all of three playing days. Every day we had enough number of the ballchildren for the wheelchairs players and if it was needed, for some of players cl.6 or 7 too. The students of the Secondary school on Friday and the pupils from the Primary school on Saturday and Sunday, helped the players well and restrainedly.

**OC+organization :** In Duesseldorf it was the first tournament of PTT but nevertheless was organized very well. Chairman of OC, Hannes Doessler had some very good co-workers for the job and together they prepared the whole tournament very well. During the tournament I asked a lot of participants after their opinion about the accommodation, meal, transport, venue and the organization of the tournament too and all of their answers were only the positive one. After the tournament we had still one informal meeting with Hannes Doessler and discussed about the possibilities of some small changes, which could help the members of OC of the next tournament in their job. I offered him for the next tournament to use the ID Card for all of participants and officials. We spoke too about some changes in the organization of the medals ceremonies. Therefore before the next tournament OC will have the experience from BSNW Open 2012, they could try to cooperate more with the Representative of Duesseldorf and maybe Region too and to try to invite some more Media for the tournament.

**In conclusion:**

Although I wrote in the last links some my opinion for the next tournament ,firstly I would like to express one's thank and to congratulate to all of members of OC, referees, umpires, classifiers, ball children and of course, all of other volunteers for the splendid work and very friendly environment of the whole tournament. The participants of BSNW Open 2012 were in Duesseldorf – at least following my small informal inquiry – very Satisfied.
