Accommodation: Organizing Committee used the Hotel Eger & Park, for all participants, except the Hungarian Umpires and couple of el. Wheelchairs users who stayed in Hotel Flora, which was 500m away.



Meals:

Breakfast, lunch and dinner in the hotel in high level quality.

Transport:

The transport between Budapest and Eger was organized very well. This year we were needed transportation between the hotel and standing hall (2 kilometres away). Vans and small buses were frequently on the way to the hall and back to the hotel.



Venues :

There were two different Venues:
Wheelchair hall



Inside the hotel a total area for 750m² (hall 5 and hall 4) with wooden floor used for 8 tables, *Lighting*: was enough 600 lux. No day light. Accessibility to the hall was without problem. Training site for all players were the halls 1-2-3 with 5 tables. Classification room was big enough inside the hotel near the training area. For informations we used the LCD monitors and wall near the organizing committee room.

Rest area was close to halls 1-2-3-4-5, big enough with a lot of tables and chairs for all, players, officials etc.

We used 8 tables full accessible for wheelchair players.

- Referee's tables:** in the middle with good view
- Computer people:** by the referee place
- Wheelchair storage:** on the entrance of playing area
- Meeting room :** 20 meter from wheelchairs' playing hall
- Internet access :** Via Wi-Fi on ground floor and in the wheelchairs' playing hall in the hotel.
- Offices :** we use the organizers office on ground floor.

Standing Hall.



1600m from hotel was the standing venue, dimension (42m X 22 m) , wooden floor. Lighting was enough about 700 lux, no day light. Gluing area was outside of venue but nobody was gluing. The standing venue was accessible and there was some spectators tribune.

We used 8 tables.

- Referee's tables:** small table in the middle with good view
- Computer people:** near the referees table
- Accessible toilets:** in the Venue there were 4 toilets an 1 accessible for the wheelchairs

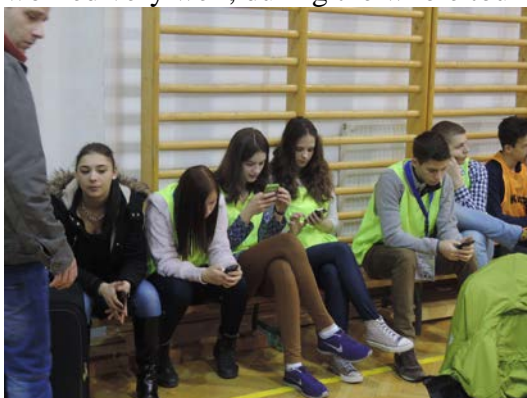

Ball boys/girls: Every day approximately 15 – 20 ball children were present in both halls. They worked very well, during the whole tournament.



Meetings : A technical meeting was held on March 12th , at 20:00 pm in the Meeting Room at 1st floor of Hotel . Organizers gave general information + draws and time schedule for the first playing day to delegations.

Classification: Original PCF: 38 players, 10 from them re-evaluations.
 In primary process classified 37 players, 1 not present in tournament.
 From this number 1 not eligible before start of tournament.
 4 more reviews not mentioned on PCF were present to classification.

Totally classified 43 players, 14 re-evaluations in this number.
 2 more re-evaluations more on demand of classifiers with change of class.
 After complete observations process 5 more Not eligible.
 Total 6 players entering the tournament were classified as Not eligible for PTT competitions after complete classification process, including observation.

Medical service: They were in the Standing Hall.



Mechanical service: It was on call service.

Ceremonies: Medal Ceremonies for single event for wheelchair players was organized after the last match in the hotel. All the other ceremonies were held at Gala dinner on 15th of March and were very nice.

Evaluation:

- Accommodations:** Very good with high level service. Meal was excellent
- Transportation:** Transport from airport to EGER and back was very well organised without problems. Also transport for standing hall was well organized.
- Sport equipment -** Good - new, ITTF and ITTF PTTD approved.
- Information:** There were 3 points for information's. Info board in the entrance of Hotel near the organizers' office. Info Board in the wheelchairs venues and Info board in standing venue.
- Referee:** Good work
- Deputy referees:** Good work.
- Umpires:** Without problems. Of course the level of umpiring was not the same as usually for all tournaments around the world.
- Computer men:** Good team's work – always in time and well.
