**Accreditation:** The accreditation was organized at the venue. Every team leader received a bag with the accreditation cards of the players, their meal tickets and plastic bottles for water.

**Distance between Hotels and Venue:** From 10min to 30min by car.

<u>Transportation:</u> Shuttle buses started at 7.30 until 09.30 and from 19.30 until 21.30 every hour and in the middle hours was on demand.





# Meals:

Breakfast and dinner was served in the hotels. Lunch was served in the venue outside next to the practice hall, under tents. Unfortunately, did not work well as there was no variety of meals and frequently long queues were created and players had to wait more than 20 min in order to be served. In the hotels (Hotel Attica 21, Hotel Holiday in Express, Hotel Blue bay) the food was very poor, without any choices and varieties.









### **Venue:** ZEM La Guinardera, Sant Cugat del Valles, Barcelona

The venue was brand new. Fully accessible for wheelchair players. In the first floor there was a bar/cafeteria.

<u>Practice Tables:</u> 7 Butterfly Centrefold 25 Tables next to the main hall




Call Area: Arranged in the practice hall next to the main hall, not very spacious. At the second day for the team event 4 tables were removed next to the entrance of the Call Area in order to give more space to the players.




<u>Changing rooms:</u> 2 for men and 1 for women – with wheelchair accessible toilets. There were also more toilets for the spectators and the players with an extra accessible toilet.





<u>Water:</u> Several water machines were available throughout the hall.



Results Service: Marta Miro made an excellent job. Always kind, patient and smiling.



**Medical service:** Available everyday throughout the tournament. Ambulance on demand, as there was a hospital 4,3km away from the venue.



Physio: There was a physio during all the competition



**Relax space:** After the end of the classifications, the classification panel was changed into a relax space for the players



**Information Board**: In the practice hall next to the main hall and the Call Area.

A classification seminar Level 1 was held from 4<sup>th</sup> until 10<sup>th</sup> of June, by Pablo Perez and Iris Serrano. There were 9 participants from 7 different countries FIN, GER, ESP, GBR, JPN, FRA and POL.

# **Classification:**

The classification was held at the venue. 2 classification panels were set up with 4 international classifiers, in a separate place in the practice hall and not in a room giving the possibility to anybody to observe the classification from the spectator's seats. Classifiers made an excellent work. 21 players were classified.





#### **Results:**

During the tournament results were published on the information board also updated on the IPTTC website. Unfortunately, the second day of the tournament there was no internet access in the venue, due to technical problems, not giving the possibility to update more frequently the results in the website.
