**Accommodation** : accommodation of the participants of Norwegian Open were in the Olympic Center and in the Ullevaal Hotel, in single and double rooms. The rooms were simple, but very efficient and comfortable. All other needed premises, were accessible for the wheelchairs.  
Meals - the breakfasts and dinners were in the accommodation and in very good quality. The Organizers served the simple, but also good lunches directly in the Venue.

**Transport** : The transport from Airport Oslo to accommodation and back was good. We needed the local transport only between Ullevaal Hotel and Venue and it was O.K. From the Olympic Center it wasn't necessary – the distance was only about 150 m.

**Venue** : The name of the sport hall was IDRETTSHEYSKOLEN. The hall is a part of Norwegian Olympic Center, near from Oslo.  
The internal dimensions of the whole hall are 75m x 45m. We used for the tournament the middle third only and the first third for the refreshment and lunch and for practice tables too.  
Floor : special lino, very good for table tennis  
Lighting : the light was a little less than 1000 Lux, but good and without some complaints from players.  
Spectator seats : no seats for spectators were there  
Referee's table : in the middle of the shorter side of playing third of hall  
Gluing room : near the vestibule.

Sept 25<sup>th</sup> : arrival day + classification + practise  
Sept 26<sup>th</sup> : Open singles, start of Team events  
Sept 27<sup>th</sup> : Team events, start of Single in classes  
Sept 28<sup>th</sup> : Singles in classes , medals ceremony  
Sept 29<sup>th</sup> : departure day of delegations

**Meetings** :  
Sept 25<sup>th</sup> : in the Olympic Center -meeting with the team leaders, The Organizers gave needed information to the delegations.



**Evaluation** :

It was the first IPTTC tournament in Norway. The level of the whole organisation was really very good . The Organizers have good conditions for the organisation of bigger tournament, for ex. Fa 30 too. It was possible to see, the experienced people worked in OC. I would like to thank all of the Organizers and volunteers for the big and very good job.
