IPTTC Recommendations	<p>If INAS is member of the IPC (after the EGA from November 2004) a World Championships cannot be organized !</p> <p>An IPTTC World Championships can be organized only every 4 years (next 2006) !</p> <p>The proposition should be to organize a World Cup – Fa 40 !</p>
Technical Delegate	To be appointed by Jiri Danek – Tournament Officer
Referee Deputy Referee	1 Main Referee to be appointed by Raul Calin – Technical Officer 2 Deputy Referee to be appointed by the Organizers
Umpires	30 umpires are to invited (40% shall be foreign umpires)
Classifiers	2 classifiers to be appointed by the classification secretary – Nico Verspeelt 2 specific classifiers to be appointed by INAS
Costs for Officials	For the TD, the Referee and the 2 IPTTC classifiers, the organizers have to provide all travel costs, accommodation and meals and a daily allowance of 15 € / day / person
Electronic results	A computer person working only on the electronic results during the tournament should to be appointed – all results must be sent to the Ranking Director within of 15 days of the competition being completed
Selections	This World Cup shall be an INAS organisation with help of the IPTTC officials. This means that to be able to participate, all the players must be eligible by INAS and IPC and that no selection system shall be used.
Capitation fees	As this is an INAS organisation, the capitation fees have to be paid directly to INAS (\$ 10 US / participant)
IPTTC help	Appointment of the TD, the Referee, the Classifiers and the ranking points.
IPTTC organisations	For the participation of the INAS ID players in official IPTTC tournaments (all factors, RC and WC), the capitation fees have to be paid to the IPTTC. In case of WC, the selection procedure shall be used by the IPTTC Selection Officer.
