Situation	<p>Weather: Bangkok weather in June; Maximum = 35°C or 95°F Minimum = 26°C or 79°F.</p> <p>History: Bangkok was established as the capital in 1782 and now houses 8 million citizens with an interesting mix of modern (shopping centres) and ancient sites (temples, palaces and monuments).</p>
Airport	<p>Airport: Suvarnabhumi Airport is about 25 kms from central Bangkok. http://www.suvarnabhumiairport.com/main_en.php</p>

Transport	<p>Airport – hotel</p> <p>Schedule: will be developed once the second entry is complete</p> <p>Number of vehicles: 5 buses for wheelchair/non-wheelchair users, 3 vans and 2 trucks (luggage).</p> <p>Accessibility: 5 buses are accessible with lifts with 1 accommodating up to 20 wheelchairs and the other 4, 8 wheelchairs each.</p> <p>Distance: about 20 kms taking between 35 to 50 minutes depending on traffic.</p> <div data-bbox="411 757 1337 1261" data-label="Image"> </div> <p>Hotel - venue</p> <p><i>Teams:</i> vehicles will be arranged per competition schedule and the stadium is very close</p> <p><i>Schedules:</i> per competition schedule</p> <p><i>Number of vehicles:</i> up to 5 buses for wheelchair/non-wheelchair user and 1 van will be available to run shuttles between the hotel and stadium</p> <p><i>Accessibility:</i> the buses are accessible vehicles.</p> <p><i>Officials</i></p> <p><i>Number of vehicles:</i> 1 van will be available to run shuttles between the hotel and stadium as necessary.</p> <p><i>Emergency</i></p> <p>Ambulance: provided by EMS by Hua Chiew General Hospital</p> <p>Accessibility: caters for disabled persons</p> <p><i>Other</i></p> <p>Site seeing: will be provided depending on the competition schedule but will include trips from 8 to 11 June 2011 with a limit of 20 persons per day.</p> <p>Number of vehicles: 1 accessible bus.</p>

Reception

Number of rooms: 270 in the hotel.

Double room (128 in the hotel):



Width of entrance door: 85cms

Width of bathroom door: 68cms – will probably need to be removed

Width of access to shower: 90cms

No grab rails in bathrooms

Plastic seats will be provided for all showers

Step to room from entrance and into bathroom 4,5cms

Bath or shower or combined: shower only

Change of linen: done as necessary but every day is possible

Safes: for valuables are available in some rooms as well as another facility in the reception

TV: available in all rooms

Bar fridge: available in all rooms

Air-conditioning: available in all rooms

Internet facilities: available in all rooms at a charge (500 Baht for 24 hours) as well as 2 computers in the reception area for general use and free wi-fi in the reception


Electrical plugs: all European 2 prong style plugs

Shop: a mini-mart is in front of the hotel

Banking or teller machine: a teller machine is between the mini-mart and hotel

Elevators (number and access for wheelchairs): 4 elevators taking 2 to 3 wheelchairs

A small fitness room: is available on the 13th floor

Swimming pool: is available but only for ambulant persons due to steps. A life-guard will be on duty during the event.

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Sport Venue	<p>Competition Venue: Bangkok Youth Centre (Thai – Japan), Thailand</p> <p>Size: 49,5m x 32,5m</p> <p>Accessibility: ramps to the venue exist, to the field of play and an additional ramp will be made for the call area to the field of play</p> <p>Aircon: is available to control the temperature</p> <p>Gluing area: a covered area is available</p> <p>Classification: a room with a reception area is available</p>

Meeting rooms: a meeting room for the technical meeting with a photocopier for schedules and results is available

Classification seminar: can be organised

Offices (TD, referees): are available

Rest areas (umpires, players): are available for umpires (room previously used for classification) and the covered area for players (with the gluing area sealed off)

Wheelchair storage: is available

Lighting: 1 000 lux; there are curtains over some windows

Seating: 3 692 available but access for wheelchairs is not possible so space should be provided on the field of play

PA: a system exists

Wi-fi: will be available in the venue during the competition

Shop: a small shop will be installed in the competition venue



Change rooms: are available at the venue for men and women plus 1 wheelchair accessible toilet for men and another for women. In addition, 2 mobile stations will be added with 2 wheelchair accessible and 3 non-accessible toilets each

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
