Free Wi-Fi service is available in the lobby as well as in the rooms.

- i) Team Referees, TD, Classifier and all Umpires were housed in the hotel.
- ii) All participants from Team Thailand were also stayed in Songphanburi which also has accessibility.
- iii) 15~20 minutes by car/bus to the venue.

The players and officials were pleased with fine facilities and the staffs are friendly and very polite.

Meals and Refreshments

The first official meal covered by the Organizing Committee was the dinner on 17 October 2017, and the last official meal was the breakfast on 22 October 2017.

Breakfast was served at hotel with varieties of good quality food, whilst lunches and dinner were served at the competition venue's hotel, National Sports Center for the Disabled, were also with good standard.

Bottled mineral water was available for all at the venue. Hot drinks like coffee and tea, with snacks/fruit were available for officials at the umpires' rest room, TD / Referee / Classifier shared room in the venue.

Accreditation

Accreditation cards without photos, a bag and a T-shirt were handed out at the Registration / Information Counter upon arrival. Training and meetings information were on the information board at the hotel information desk and also through Liaison personel of each team.



Transport

Transport between airports in Bangkok and hotel was fairly well organized. The organiser provided 5 buses for wheelchair / non-wheelchair users, and 6 vans for non-wheelchair users and truck van for luggage service. 3 vans and a bus were available used for officials at all time from Hotel-Venue and vice versa. The transport service provided between hotel and competition venue on practice days and competition days was good.



Medical

Throughout the competition, medical staffs were on duty/stand-by in the center room and on the field of play whilst an ambulance at all time was available at the venue.





Competition Venue: National Sports Center for the Disabled, Suphanburi, Thailand

- A total of 16 Table Tennis Tables were used for competition with Table 1 and Table 2 were used for live broadcast on the internet (YouTube).
- Competition Hall 1 was arranged with 12 Table Tennis Tables, and this included 2 are non-wheelchair Tables.
- Spectator Seating: 300 seats available with a good view of the playing area.

Practice Hall

- Competition Hall 2 was using 4 Table Tennis Tables which were wheelchair friendly.
- The flooring is synthetic rubber mats laid over parquet flooring in Hall 1 and practice area in Hall 2. While the Hall 2 competition area was using badminton sport floor mat.
- Twelve tables for practice were set up in the same hall as the competition hall 2 (partitioned off by barriers and screens).
- Both the competition halls and practice area lighting was good and were well presented.
- Call area is located at the Center Room, next to Competition Hall 1





All washrooms in the 3 halls are wheelchair accessible

- Rest rooms for male and female players next to the call area.
- Racket control, for education purpose, is partitioned at the call area for accessibility.
- Information and results were updated all the time at Information board and pigeon boxes.
- Competition management table with allocation of table space for Referee team, TD, Computer personnel, Tournament & Result team was set up with good view at the side middle front of the field of play.
- Wheelchair repair service was located outside the Center room.
- There was Wi-Fi in the hall free for everybody.
- Rooms provided in Competition Hall 1 were TD/Classifier/Referees' shared room, Umpires' room,
- Volunteers' rest area in Hall 1 and LOC working place is at both Hall 1 and at hotel's information counter.
- Washrooms and change rooms; enough for both men and women wheelchair accessible located in all the halls.
- The following equipment was used:
 - Tables: 12 Andro Magnum SCW blue tables, 2 Butterfly tables and 2 Donic tables approved by ITTF were used for competition, 12 Donic tables were used in the practice area in Hall 2.
 - > Net & Post: Andro black approved by ITTF
 - **Balls:** Butterfly G40+ 3* white approved by ITTF
 - > Umpire tables and Towel boxes: Andro, ITTF approved
 - > Scoreboards: Andro, ITTF approved
 - > **Surroundings:** Andro and Donic
 - > **Umpire chairs**: Double Happiness
