Hotel Slnava:

The rooms were acceptable for wheelchairs, except the doors of the bathrooms (60cm only).

Entrance of the hotel and all of needed rooms were acceptable for wheelchairs too, four lifts were acceptable for wheelchairs there.

There we had all of the meals, in a very good quality.

<u>Venue:</u> The Main Sport Hall MHK was situated only approximately 300 m from the hotels.
