All the hotels were *** or **** level. In some of them wheelchairs had problems with the bathroom doors and in some of them with shower baths. Accessibility of loby, rooms, dining rooms were O.K. Participants had no

other problems in hotels.

Breakfast and dinner were taken in hotels. Lunch was in restaurant near from

hall or dirrectly in venue. All of meals were in good quality.
