Meals were served on the basis self-servis in very good quality.

The <u>Laleh Hotel</u> from September 20 to September 30. 2005 about 30 minutes drive far from the venue. The rooms, bathrooms and dining room were acceptable for wheelchairs. woman worked in the special room, close to the playing hall

Officials' room: No special room for it, officials used the office the club;

First aid (doctor) was located in the playing hall.
