Meetings: The technical meeting was hold on May 30th, at 9 pm in the meeting room

of the hotel Golden Tulip. The managers of the delegations got there all of needed general information, and draw of the Singles + time schedule for

the first day.

<u>Classification</u>: The classification was conducted on May 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. The first day it was in

the Lamont Centre for the Romanian players only. There were classified 14 players for the national Championships. The second day was classification in the Venue for other 8 players from the official list. From this number 5 were new and 3 for review. During the next days, the classifiers observed some of

players.

Both of areas for the classification were good prepared and with the appropriate equipment, needed privacy and with the local interpreter too. Organizers prepared the refreshment for the classifiers too.

#### **Results**:

Already when some part of the event was finished, the Organizers gave the results on the inform desk and after the Single in classes all of the delegations got the written results through the pigeonholes. During the Farewell Party, Organizers gave all of Results of RITTO 2012 to the Delegations on the Memory sticks.

When we finished the singles in classes the Referee sent the results on IPTC web side immediately and after the end of the tournament the results from Team event he sent there too.

<u>Medical service</u>: During the whole tournament the doctor was present in the First aid room in

the Venue.

<u>Ceremonies</u>: The short Opening Ceremony was immediately before the start of the Single in classes.

The both of the medals Ceremonies were organized after the end of the Team events. On June 2<sup>nd</sup> evening were the Farewell party in the hotel Golden Tulip.

**Evaluation:** Accommodations – only the officials, the umpires and the Polish team were abed at the hotel Premier. All of other participants of the RITTO 2012 were abed at the hotel Golden Tulip. The level of accommodation were very similar and in the both of the hotels really very good. The hotel Golden Tulip was fully accessible for the wheelchairs – -from entry, lobby, dining room and conference room. Two lifts are there (doors 80cm), room doors 85cm, bathrooms doors 72cm and the right equipment were there too. In the hotel were still four bigger rooms, directly for wheelchair players.

#### Transport -

The both of transports -Airport – hotels and local, hotels– Venue were organized very well, with the corresponding number of the needed buses and minibuses.

**Sport equipment -** Very good, ITTF approved and accessible for the wheelchair players.

Information:

The time schedule and draw were on the information board. There were always the actual results during the events too. All of the next information for the participants. were in the pigeonholes. The level of the information system was good.

**Referee** + **deputy**: Very good and professional work – all was always prepared in time and during the tournament we hadn't some protest. All the events finished in time. They organized very well the umpires.

**Umpires:** 

OC had for the tournament together 25 umpires from 6 countries: ROU - 8, BEL - 1, SRB - 4, HUN - 7, SVK - 4, ITA - 1. We had no some protest again their job.

**Computer service:** The two computer officers cooperate well with OC and officials... During the tournament approximately 400 volunteers cooperated with the Organizing Committee of RITTO 2012. They were mostly from the Little People Association and from the Lamont Centre too. Mostly they were young girls and boys which tried to help with the organization of the tournament in the different functions.

Ball boys/girls:

Approximately 100 from the volunteers helped OC very well as ball boys/girls. They were very disciplinary and therefore they helped the wheelchairs during their matches very well.

**OC+organization**: Therefore it was already the 6<sup>th</sup> RITTO, the organizers around Sally Wood-Lamont hade a lot of the experiences with the job. The whole team had to work very well not only when they started to prepare the tournament, but of course, mainly during that one too. I am sure, that the participants could be really satisfied there. Organizing Committee and the volunteers prepared for all of the participants very friendly environment during the whole tournament in Cluj-Napoca.
