snack too. The classifiers, Sandra Sonn and Dr. All-Dujili Mudheher formed the very good team and therefore the classification was made without some

problems,.

Results: The running results were on the special inform desk, by the entry of the main playing hall. The final tournament results were send by e-mail to each Delegation.

Medical service:

During the whole tournament were present in the playing hall the nurse and the physiotherapist. Before the playing hall was the whole time the ambulance car prepared too. Dr. Ali Alhaded from the Quine Allia Military Hospital was responsible for the medical service in the whole time of the tournament. During the tournament, one German player, Karl – Heinz Konig had to be transported to hospital with the severe muscle Spasm and after the treatment Voltaren injection he could go on in the tournament. Also one Indian player, Pydirama Kottinti was with the dislocated left shoulder in the hospital. He was treated by the Pethidine injection and his left shoulder was relocated. The medical service of the Al Watani tournament was top-level.

Ceremonies:

Opening Ceremony was organized on April 11th at 5 pm. President of Jordan Paralympic Committee, HRH Prince Ra´ad Bin Zeid opened the tournament. Medals Ceremonies were organized well, always after the finish of the event. After the dinner on April 13th, was organized in the hall of the hotel the short Closing ceremony, where the Dr.Ali Smadi and Maher Barhoom from OC finished the tournament and gave to everyone the nice personal certify about their participation of the Al Watani Open 2013.
