Accommodation: All the participants and officials were housed in Taichung Harbor

Hotel, 6.7 km to Venue, about 15 minutes by bus. Accessibility was

good, free internet access and received good remarks from

All accredited participants and officials had the first official meal covered by the Organizing Committee was the dinner on 21st Aug 2015, and the last official meal will be the breakfast on 25th Aug 2015. Very good quality food served at all time.

Transport:



Transport was organizing well from and to the airport. Shuttle transport services were provided between the Hotel and the playing venue following time schedule of every 30 min. from 0730; and 60 min from 0900 hours.

Accreditation:

The accreditation was carried out from 19th Aug. 2015 at the official hotel. Each participant received a tag, a manual, a small back-pack, luggage tag, pin, towel and a t-shirt as souvenirs.





- ➤ Lighting: very good, 1000 lux, no day light
- Capacity: aprox. 2,000. Spectators can view games by standing/sitting on 3rd floor viewing platform. Alongside the walls of the competition venue have retractable seats for ball boys/girls, teams and players at play.
- > Referee's and official's tables: at elevated level and in front of competition tables
- ➤ Computer table: behind the referee's desk
- ➤ Call Area: located at the foyer, outside the competition venue at 2nd floor
- ➤ Gluing area: outside the call area.
- Internet access: Wi-Fi connection in the hall for everybody.
- ➤ Rooms provided are: TD/Referees' room, Umpires' rest room, Racket Control Room (for education), men and women's players' rest rooms.

> Washrooms & changing rooms: enough for both Men and Women wheelchair accessible.



- > Wheelchair service corner: to provide wheelchairs repair service.
- ➤ Wheelchair storage: located along the side of the main hall.



- ➤ Water: Water was free available during the tournament for all delegations, staff and volunteers.
- ➤ Information and pigeon boxes: information and results updated by organiser all the time.

Equipment: Tables: 16 tables approved by ITTF in competition hall (8 are accessible for wheelchairs) & 12 tables for training in the practice hall at 1st floor of the venue.





Net & Post were from SUNFLEX Pro. Balls used were Nittaku Sha 40+ (white) 3stars. Sport wood flooring at Competition Hall, and good quality sport floor mat at the Practice Hall. Umpire tables & towel boxes are from TSP. Scoreboards were Nittaku and surrounds were blue in colour with various advertisements.
